Summary

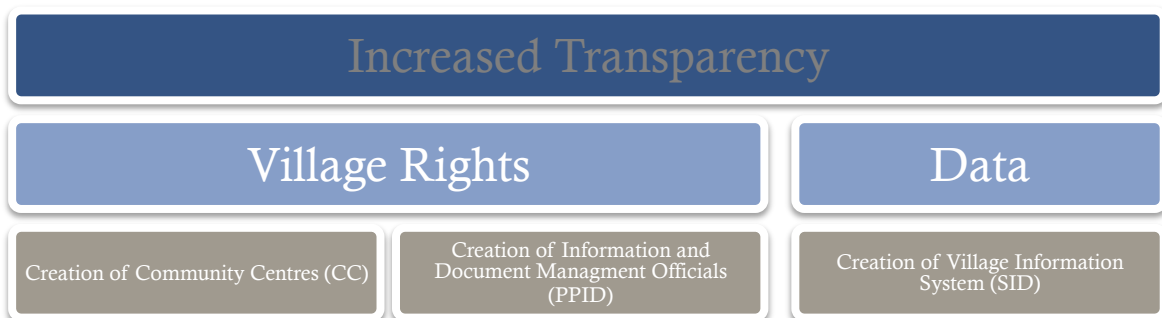
Since 2008, JMS Lombok has been actively involved in advocacy work at the village and district levels across Lombok Island, Indonesia. They want to increase transparency in the governing of Lombok. JMS has built partnerships with the Village and District Governments and with citizens to build Community Center's (CC). There are currently 42 CC's in 3 districts (West Lombok, North Lombok and Central Lombok).

JMS, working with the community, has identified 7 (seven) main issues that have an impact on village's lives:

1. Proper health advocacy for the poor
2. Advocating the distribution of rice aid for the poor,
3. Fulfillment of children's right to get education,
4. Supervision of school admission to new schools elimination of illegal levies,
5. Fulfillment of the rights of children on birth certificates,
6. Fulfillment of marriage books for married couples who do not have a marriage book,
7. Advocacy around stopping the violence of women and children in the household.

In response to these 7 issues, JMS has identified a 3-step pathway to addressing all of these issues. These solutions are based on information management and systems. This three-step pathway leads to the rolling out of SID into every Desa in West Lombok.

- Step One - Creation of Community Centers
- Step Two - Creation of Information and Document Management Officials is complete.
- Step Three – Creation of SID



2017 – Year in Review

Village Information Systems - JMS Lombok encouraged the village governments to build a Village Information Systems (SID) through an Open SID application. This is in accordance with the mandate of Law no. 6 year 2014 on the Village. The aim was to facilitate the PPID's in the villages to manage data and information, to be more effective and provide quick administration services to the citizens. Community can also access information about development in the village easily.

In 2017 JMS delivered 50 training sessions and commenced the development of Open SID in 5 villages.
